

Regional Health and Social Care Information Sharing Agreement

Information Governance Steering Group Key Decisions 14th April 2020

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Policy – Surrey Heartlands Information Sharing Agreement (SHISA)

The IGSG policy recommendation regarding organisations' membership of SHISA and the Regional ISA is:

1. The major health and social care organisations should be signatories to both arrangements. Examples are:
 - a. Frimley Health NHS Foundation Trust;
 - b. Surrey and Borders Partnership NHS Foundation Trust;
 - c. Surrey County Council; and
 - d. Phyllis Tuckwell Hospice Care.
2. Practices within the Frimley ICS should not be asked to sign up to both frameworks.
3. Sharing arrangements that are Surrey-wide and include Surrey Heath and Farnham and potentially North East Hampshire should be implemented through the Regional ISA. Examples of these arrangements are:
 - a. The Surrey-wide Primary Care Network based Mental Health arrangements; and
 - b. The Surrey Care Record.
4. The Regional ISA Administrator will issue and manage the required Information Governance documentation within the Frimley ICS on behalf of the Surrey-wide programmes.
5. Additional approvals for these arrangements from IGSG will not normally be required. Approval by the Surrey Heartlands Data Governance Group (SHDGG) will normally suffice.
