Regional Health and Social Care Information Sharing Agreement

Publications Policy – All Platforms

It is recognised that from time to time data sourced from a jointly controlled information asset managed under the Regional Health and Social Care Information Sharing Agreement will be used to support or as part of publication. This policy sets out the conditions that any such publication needs to satisfy.

For the purposes of this policy, examples of “publication” includes without limitation:

- A. Presentation at in person and online meetings where attendance extends beyond organisations that are members of the Regional Health and Social Care Information Sharing Agreement;
- B. Presentation at in person and online conferences;
- C. Publication of articles, papers, reports, videos, podcasts in academic and other journals and on websites and other media channels;
- D. Distribution of structured and unstructured datasets; and
- E. Interviews.

For the purposes of this policy:

- 1. No personal identifiable data from the TVS Care Record may be published under any circumstances;
- 2. No data directly or indirectly identifying a Regional Health and Social Care Information Sharing Agreement joint controller organisation may be published without prior written permission; and
- 3. No data directly or indirectly identifying an employee of or contractor to a Regional Health and Social Care Information Sharing Agreement joint controller organisation may be published without prior written permission.

Prior written permission can be given by either the joint controller organisations themselves or by a fully quorate sitting of the IG Steering Group for the Regional Health and Social Care Information Sharing Agreement.

For the purposes of this policy, the jointly controlled information assets are:

- 1. Connected Care;
- 2. My Care Record;
- 3. Surrey Care Record;
- 4. Thames Valley and Surrey Care Record; and
- 5. Including the intelligence and analytics platforms supporting these information assets.

This policy takes effect from 13th June 2023 and expires on the 30th April 2028.
